US bars China supercomputer firms, institute from buying American parts

The US thinks that the Chinese companies pose a major risk of being involved in activities contrary to the national security of United States

THE US COMMERCE Department said on Friday it was adding several Chinese companies and a government-owned institute involved in supercomputing with military applications to its national security "entity list" that bars them from buying US parts and components without government approval. The export restriction announcement, adding the firms to what is effectively a trade blacklist, is the latest effort by the Trump administration to restrict the ability of Chinese firms to gain access to US technology and conduct business with the US.

The department said it was adding Sugon, the Wuhan Jiangnan Institute of Computing Technology, Higao, Chengdu Haiguang Integrated Circuit and Chengdu Halgunq Microelectronic Technology—along with numerous aliases of the five entities—to the list over concerns about military applications of the supercomputers they are developing.

Wuxi Jiangnan Institute of Computing Technology is owned by the 56th Research Institute of the General Staff of China's People's Liberation Army, the Commerce Department said, adding "in mission is to support China's military mod-

Huawei files lawsuit against US Commerce Department over seized equipment

HUAWEI TECHNOLOGIES CO Ltd filed a lawsuit against the US Commerce Department on Friday challenging whether telecommunications equipment it sent from China to the United States, and then back to China, is covered by Export Administration Regulations, according to a court filing. The lawsuit is the latest salvo in a battle over what US officials say is a violation of the US government and Huawei. Washington says the Chinese company's telecommunications gear could be used by Beijing to spy. Huawei denies that is the case.

ernization." The Chinese Embassy in Washington did not immediately return a request for comment. China's state broadcaster, China Radio International, said in an editorial on Saturday that the move was one of a series of recent actions by the United States that violated the consensus reached by President Donald Trump and his Chinese counterpart, Xi Jinping, in Argentina last December.

"No matter whether it is aimed at suppressing Chinese technology or its long-term economic development, or put pressure on China in the trade negotiations, the United States will

not achieve its aims," it said. In 2015, the Commerce Department added China's National University of Defense Technology (NUDT) to the list "because of its use of US-origin multicores, boards, and processors to power supercomputers believed to support nuclear explosive simulation and military simulation activities." The Commerce Department said on Friday that since 2015 NUDT has procured items under the name Human Guofang Kai University, using four separate additional addresses not already on the entity list. The department said on Friday it is now adding

to the list of entities that have received a removal order from a US immigration court.

The Washington Post reported on Friday that the operation is slated to launch on Sunday and is expected to target up to 2,000 families facing deportation orders in as many as 10 US cities, including Houston, Chicago, Miami and Los Angeles.

A spokesman for ICE declined to comment, saying it would not reveal details on operations before their conclusion. Chicago's Mayor Lori Lightfoot said she had terminated ICE's access to Chicago Police Department (CPD) databases related to federal immigration enforcement activities in response to the threat of raids. "I have also personally spoken with ICE leadership in Chicago and voiced my strong objection to any such raids."

Further, I reiterated that CPD will not cooperate with or facilitate any ICE enforcement actions," Lightfoot said in a statement.

The Los Angeles Police Department said in a series of tweets it would not participate or assist in the immigration enforcement actions.

Houston's Mayor Sylvester Turner noted in a statement the "rich cultural contributions" of the city's immigrants, and said: "The city does not try to impede ICE's job, nor does it try to impede ICE." Morgan earlier this week that ICE wanted to deport families who had recently arrived illegally in the United States to discourage more Central Americans

AMAZON.COM INC is exploring using drones not just to deliver packages but also to provide surveillance as a service to its customers, according to a patent granted by the United States Patent and Trademark Office.



The delivery drones can be used to record video of a consumer's property to gather data that can be analyzed to look out, for example, a broken window, or a fire if or a garage door was left open during the day, the patent describes.

According to the patent, the surveillance function of the drone can be limited through geo-fencing, a technology used to draw a virtual boundary around the property under surveillance.

Any image or data that the drone captures outside the geo-fence would be obscured or removed.

The application for the patent was filed by the e-commerce giant in 2015 and granted on June 4.

Earlier this month, Amazon said it will start drones delivering packages to customers in 30 minutes or less in the coming months.

US cities brace for immigration raids, say they will not participate

US CITIES EXPECTING to be hit by a wave of immigration raids intended to deport recently arrived families who are in the United States illegally said on Friday they would not cooperate with federal authorities.

In a call with reporters earlier this week, Mark Morgan, the acting director of the US Immigration and Customs Enforcement, said the agency would target for deportation families that have received a removal order from a US immigration court.

The Washington Post reported on Friday that the operation is slated to launch on Sunday and is expected to target up to 2,000 families facing deportation orders in as many as 10 US cities, including Houston, Chicago, Miami and Los Angeles.

The number of migrants apprehended crossing the US-Mexico border surged in May to the highest level since 2006. Most of the migrants are fleeing violence, poverty and corruption in Central America, and are seeking asylum, a process that can take years. Many families are released into the United States for the duration of the process because of limits on how long children can be detained.

The Department of Homeland Security did not immediately respond to a request for comment.

Separately, the governor of Texas said the state was deploying 1,000 National Guard troops to the border after he said more than 45,000 people were apprehended illegally crossing in the past three weeks.


FDA approves drug for loss of sexual desire in women

THE US DRUG regulator on Friday approved Palatin Technologies' drug to restore sexual desire in premenopausal women, the latest attempt to come up with a therapy that some have dubbed as "female Viagra".

The therapy, Vyleesi, will compete in a market which has seen previous attempts fail. Analysts have said that a drug that safely and effectively treats loss of sexual desire in women could eventually reach annual sales of about \$1 billion. Palatin's share jumped 44% to \$1.93, while Amgen's share rose 11.5% after market. Vyleesi, chemically known as bremanotadol, activates pathways in the brain involved in sexual desire, helping premenopausal women with hypoactive sexual desire disorder (HSDD).

The drug will compete with Sprout Pharmaceuticals' Addyi, a once-daily pill that was approved for HSDD in 2015 with a warning restricting alcohol use when on the medication. It will be available from September through select pharmacies.

Boris Johnson's brush with police puts leadership bid in turmoil

BORIS JOHNSON'S BID to become the UK's next prime minister was thrown into turmoil after an argument with his partner prompted police to visit his London residence. Officers were called to the home Johnson shares with Carrie Symonds shortly after midnight on Friday, hours after it was confirmed as the front-runner in the race to succeed Theresa May.

Police said they found no cause for action at both Johnson and Symonds were safe and well after a neighbour raised concerns for her safety. But the incident dominated Saturday's UK newspapers and threatened to damage Johnson's campaign at a critical time in the Conservative Party leadership
