In sales expenses, the highest item is the costs of payroll of the creative staff; And in the administrative expenses is the Designit Group fee, which is composed of those general costs of the company that the group distributes among all the offices.

The financial incomes are composed for the currency translation differences, generated in the payment of invoices to our foreign suppliers like Designit Spain Digital S, L and On Tax & Legal. And also, due to the interest perceived in the corporate savings bank account.

Social Equity Tax: The company have to pay the 9% over Fiscal Net Income (Invoiced Revenues Less Permitted Deductions); That Permitted deductions are the operational expenses required for make possible the normal business operation. If the Fiscal Net Income is greater than 800.000.000 COP (Legal Base), we have to pay additionally, a surcharge of 6% over the difference between the Fiscal Net Income and the Base.

Tax Withheld per foreign Customers: This is a tax withheld by Designit Perú. It is the thirty five percent over the invoice net value and the company cannot use it as a discount of his annual tax declaration.

Consumption Tax: This is a tax that take place when the company has expenses like lunch or dinner with a client, in order to do business development.

Industry and Commerce Tax (ICA): It is a council tax. the tariff is 1% over our Invoiced Revenues, plus 15% of the tax to pay, less the retained industry and commerce tax (ICA) per our clients.

Tax Advances:

Withholding VAT to Foreign Suppliers: The company calculates the 16% of the invoice and we have to pay this amount to the tax authority. It is an advance for our VAT annual declaration.

Withholding VAT to Simplified regime: The company calculates the 2,4% of the invoice value, and we have to pay this amount to the tax authority. It is an advance for our VAT annual declaration.

Property, Plant & Equipment:

The technical installations include the adjustments that were made to the main office, and are depreciating to five years, because it is the duration of the lease of the same.
